

government recognised qualification. Once a teacher successfully completes the iQTS qualification, they will automatically be awarded the qualification required to teach in English schools.

Offering iQTS to your staff is a great way to demonstrate your commitment to their professional development. The iQTS programme is a rigorous initial teacher education programme that supports new teachers to understand and apply key principles from evidence and research in the classroom. It ensures that participants meet the standards which are essential elements of quality teaching:

**iQTS Teachers' Standards**





A placement in a different school is an opportunity for students to broaden their experience and develop as a professional. Ideally, all students will spend approximately 2-4 weeks in a different school. This requirement may not apply to students who have previous teaching experience in a different school prior to beginning the course.

If it is not possible to arrange a second school placement, students will complete a one-week virtual school shadowing task including video observation and/or remote teaching.
